



Covid 19 Dog walking and handover procedures

The CFSG have provided guidance for pet business owners on how to manage the handover of pets. I've based my policy on their advice which can be found here:

My new policy for dog walking is outlined below:

- I will avoid using my bicycle where possible, but when unavoidable every care will be taken to avoid cross contamination
- I will collect your dog from your front door or inner hallway with a minimum of contact
- I will use my own biothane lead for walks. The lead will be disinfected after every walk
- Although the guidance does allow for it, for the time being I will not be walking dogs from different households together, the only exception to this will be if I have an extra person with me to ensure the dogs can be kept separate to minimize the risk of cross contamination
- If you are in the 'vulnerable' category and shielding, or if you have symptoms of Covid 19 please let me know. Your pet will need to be disinfected as a precaution before and after every walk. I intend to use Leucillin spray for this, however if you prefer to use your own wipes that's also fine. There is a link below to a review of Leucillin spray
- I will be using hand sanitizer before entering your home and once again on leaving
